7 Blooket (game)	Line up your troll dolls, put on your lucky shirt, and get ready to yell BINGO! Take on the role of a pirate, and steal gold from other players while answering questions about Starsky and Hutch. Fun can be had without knowing anything about the show. Against Humanity!
(game)

This is Cards Against Humanity, S&H style! Thanks to Krisser CI5 who came up with a version for The Professionals fandom and Cyanne who helped develop our version. Tech Support will lead us as we play this online!

In a nutshell, the rules are: Each round, every player gets several Answer Cards with different words or phrases. A Question Card is then presented to the group. Each player chooses an Answer Card from their hand that they feel fits the question. The answers are revealed anonymously and the players vote for the best one. The player whose answer gets the most votes wins that round and gets a point. Whoever gets to 5 points first is the winner!

If this sounds complicated, don't worry. Once you see it in action, you'll get it. And you don't need to be an S&H trivia buff to win. Interpret "best" however you please--sometimes a hilariously 'wrong' answer will be chosen over a more technically 'correct' one. Players and onlookers alike will have a rollicking good time.
